The Frontline team is always looking to expand. If you are willing to be a joyful greeter and help first time guests, see Pastor Jeremy or Beth Pettis.

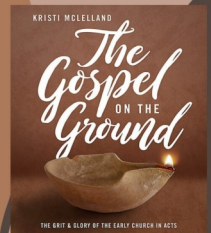

We PRAISE the Lord for the great things He is doing at TCS this school year! We are deeply humbled and greatly blessed to see Him answering our prayers and providing in ways that are beyond our expectations!

I recently shared a short list of some of the exciting things that are happening:

- TCS is entering its 49th year of ministry.
- We are PRAISING the Lord that our enrollment is the highest it has been in some time. We started school on August 10 with 403 students. As of this writing, we may soon welcome our 410th student. This is an increase of 80 students over the start of the 2021-2022 school year.
- TCS is fully accredited by ACSI and COGNIA.
- We are expanding *Project Lead the Way* for our K5-4th grade students. This hands-on STEAM curriculum is designed to teach and encourage problem solving and critical thinking as well as a love for **Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math**.
- We are also offering a Technology class each week for our K5-4th grade students.
- We have enhanced school security by employing a security guard to be on campus every school day.
- We hosted a Spiritual Emphasis event for our secondary students on Tuesday, August 23, that encouraged our students to start the year well – with a focus on being real in their relationship with God.
- We received the provision of an additional 7 acres of land that will help to provide athletic fields and activity space to serve everyone at Trinity. This brings our campus size to nearly 20 acres!
- We have new classroom technology upgrades and have made cosmetic updates to our nearly 100,000 square foot facility.
- Trinity is Debt Free and in a solid financial position.
- TCS is supporting each student's growth – spiritually, academically, and socially – so that they can love God with their whole heart, mind, and soul.

Please continue to PRAY for the Trinity Christian School family as we have started this new school year. PRAY that the Lord will help us to prepare young people with the spiritual and academic foundation to obey God's will for their lives and to walk in a manner worthy of their calling.
